2. COUNCILLORS' INDECISIVENESS AT THIS STAGE IS IN CHARACTER.

THEY WILL WANT TO AVOID LEADERSHIP OF OR COMMITMENT AND TO TRIM
TO WHAT THEY SEE AS THE PREVAILING WIND. BUT: FROM THE THREE
MEETINGS HELD AND FROM PRIVATE CONVERSATIONS, OUR TENTATIVE
ASSESSMENT IS THAT FOUR COUNCILLORS WOULD BE PERSONALLY READY
TO SEE LEASEBACK EXPLORED: FOUR UNDECIDED: TWO AGAINST.
THEY WILL ALL CONTINUE TO WAVER - BUT LEASEBACK REMAINS FIRMLY
ON THE TABLE. IT IS NOW IMPORTANT THAT, UNDER GOVERNOR'S
STIMULATION, COUNCILLORS ACTIVELY CANVASS ISLANDER OPINION AND
MAINTAIN MOMENTUM OF INTERNAL DEBATE. BY 6 JANUARY WE WILL
HAVE TO DECIDE WHETHER TO FORCE A DECISION OR TO LET THINGS
SIMMER LONGER.

4. FACT THAT ISSUES ARE NOW OUT IN THE OPEN CAN ONLY BE

BENEFICIAL (APART FROM BEING UNAVOIDABLE). COUNCILLORS WOULD

PROVIDED THAT WE ARE SEEN TO BE GENUINELY CONSULTING AND RESPECTING ISLANDERS' WISHES WITHOUT PRESSURE OR ULTIMATA (PARA 3 OF STANLEY TELNO 183) EXERCISE, WHATEVER ITS FINAL OUTCOME, WILL HELP TO CONCENTRATE MINDS IN ISLANDS AS WELL AS IN UK AND ARGENTINA ON REALITIES OF SITUATION AND CN LIMITS OF AVAILABLE OPTIONS.

PRECLUDED BY ISLANDERS FROM MAINTAINING ANY POLITICAL DIALOGUE WITH ARGENTINA (COUNCILLORS SEEM FULLY AWARE OF THIS).

SECOND, WE MUST MEANWHILE KEEP OUR LINES OPEN WITH ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT AND AVOID GIVING THEM TOO DIFFICULT A HAND TO PLAY:

TOO STRIDENT OR EXCLUSIVE ADVOCACY OF LEASEBACK BY US COULD BUILD UP PUBLIC INTER-SERVICE OPPOSITION IN ARGENTINA AND RISK FORECLOSING THE OPTION.
