IMPLEMENTATION OF EFFICIENCY SCRUTINIES

She would be grateful if the Efficiency Unit would itself carry out a scrutiny of the way in which earlier scrutinies have been implemented, and make recommendations on how that process can be made more effective to ensure continuing improvements in value for money.
