YOUR TELNO 141: HINDO-BRITTHISH RELATIONS AND WESTLANDS CONTRACT

- 1. II HAVE STILL NOT BEEN ABLE TO SEE THE DEFENCE MINISTER.

 MY MEETHING WITH GHAREKHAN IN THE PRIME MINHSTER'S OFFICE ON

 4 FEBRUARY (MY TELNO 167) AND WITH PARTHASARATHY ON 5 FEBRUARY

 (MY TELNO 175) WERE NOT DISCOURAGING. BUT THEY HAVE NOT YET

 BORNE ANY FRUIT: THE INDIANS ARE STILL DECLINING TO TALK TO

 WESTLANDS. THERE HS NOT MUCH TIME LEFT HF WE WANT RESULTS

 BEFORE WESTLANDS AGM ON 13 FEBRUARY.
- 2. HI SHALL TRY TO SEE THE DEFENCE SECRETARY AND FUNANCE SECRETARY AGAIN, BUT EXPECT TO FIND THEM UNABLE TO MOVE WHITHOUT A (FURTHER) GREEN LENGHT FROM THE PRIME MINISTER. HI SHALL KEEP AFTER THE DEFENCE MINISTER: BUT HE HIS CLEARLY PLAYING HARD TO GET. HIN THE CHRCUMSTANCES, HI THINK HI SHOULD NOW MAKE A DETERMINED EFFORT TO SEE THE PRIME MINISTER HIMSELF. THIS MAY WELL NOT BE POSSIBLE, GIVEN HIS EXPECTED ABSENCE FROM DELHIS. BUT IN COULD OF COURSE OFFER TO MEET HIM ANYWHERE HIN HINDHA THAT SUBTED HIM: AND EVEN AN UNSUCCESSFUL ATTEMPT TO SEE HIM MIGHT DO SOMETHING TO DEMONSTRATE OUR CONCERN BOTH HERE AND VIDA—A—VIIS WESTLANDS.
- 3. HF YOU AGREE, THEREFORE, IN PROPOSE TO ASK GHAREKHAN TOMORROW MORNING HF HE CAN ARRANGE FOR ME TO CALL ON THE PRHME MINISTER HIN THE NEXT 2 OR 3 DAYS. HIT WOULD STRENGTHEN MY HAND HF HI COULD SAY THAT HI WAS SEEKHING THIS APPOINTMENT ON MRS THATCHER'S HINSTRUCTHONS, HIN THE LHIGHT OF HER CONCERNS WHICH HI EXPLAINED ON 4 FEBRUARY. HIT WOULD ALSO HELP HF HI COULD REFER TO THE AGM AS A SPECIFIC REASON FOR A MEETHING HIN GOOD THME BEFORE 13 FEBRUARY.
- 4. IF IN DO SEE THE PRIME MINISTER, IN THINK IN SHOULD COVER THE FOLLOWING POINTS IN ADDITION TO THOSE IN PARAS 1. AND 2 OF YOUR TURE
- (A) MRS THATCHER'S PERSONAL CONCERN ABOUT THE SHIKH EXTREMISTS HAN BRITAIN AND THE DANGER WHICH THESE POSE FOR HADHA (AND BRITAIN). HER DETERMINATION TO DO ALL WE CAN TO HELP, AND THE HAMPORTANCE SHE ATTACHES TO THE CURRENT CLOSE COOPERATION

(B) HER CONCERN ABOUT THE SATUATION OF WESTLANDS, WHO HAVE UNCURRED EXPENDATURE IIN ORDER TO MEET AN HADDIAN (DEA) THE TABLE AND ON THE STRENGTH OF UNDIAN ASSURANCES: AND THE DANGER OF THIS LEADING TO DAMAGING CONTROVERSY AT (AND AFTER) THE AGM.

(C) HER WHIDER CONCERN THAT UNLESS THE CURRENT DRIFT HIS ARRESTED,
STRONG ANTH-HADHAN FEELHINGS WHILL BE GENERATED HIN BRHITAMIN
(ON THE GROUNDS THAT WE ARE BEHING UNFAHRLY DRISCRIMINATED AGAINST)
AND THAT THE VALUED RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES WHILL
BE SERHOUSLY HAMPAHRED.
